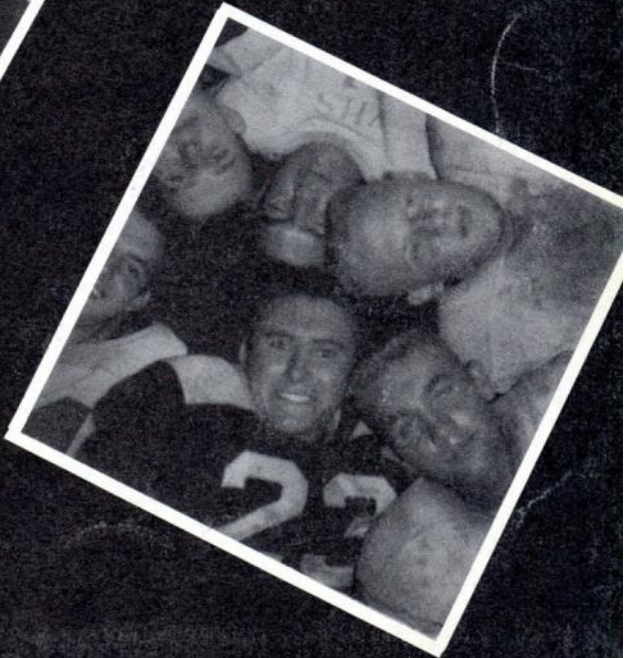


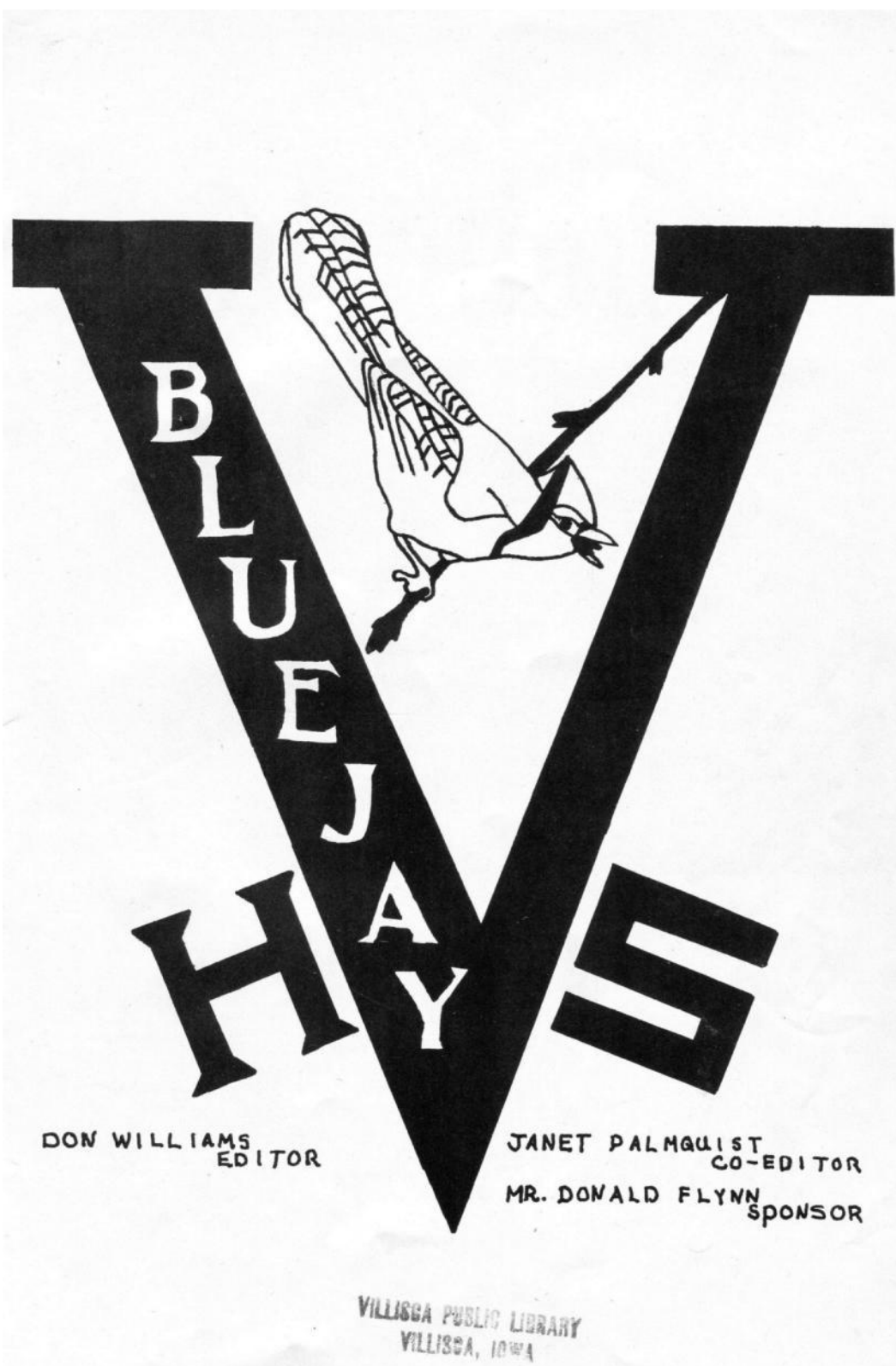

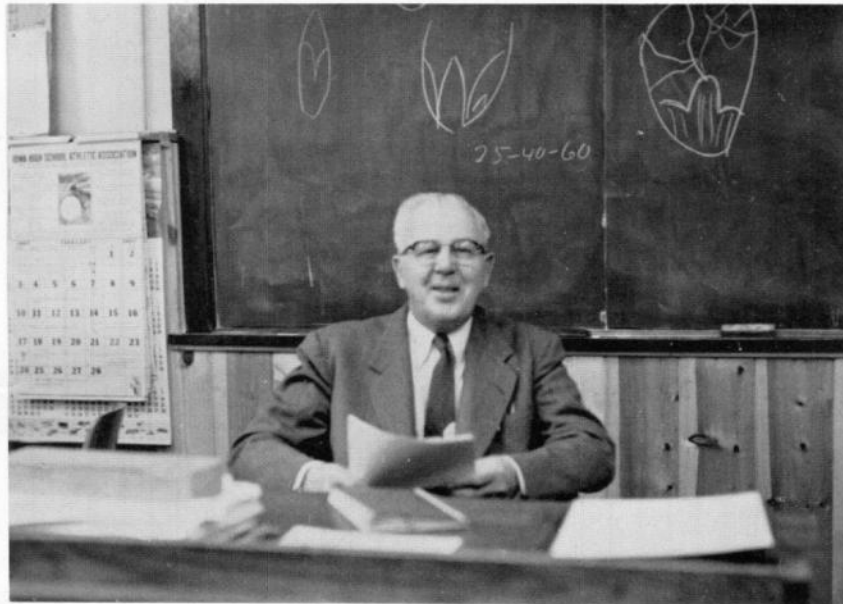








# Dedication

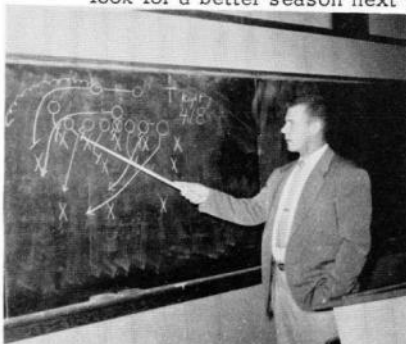
The Villisca Blue Jays started the season with a 13-6 victory over Bedford.
