With the loss to Griswould in the last game, their playoff hopes seemed shattered, but the tie breaker put them in the playoffs against Fremont-Mills. After defeating F-M 28-13 in first round, the Jays lost to Lone Tree 20-8 in the Semifinals. This was the first time the Jays made the State playoffs. Rick Behrens and Kevin Schafer were named all-state and all SWI. Todd England, Rick Behrens, Kevin Schafer, Doug Means, Scott Leichty, Scott Neal, Keith Haley, Jim Boggess, Dan Kernen, were all named to all Conference teams. Rick Behrens was selected to play in the Shrine Bowl game. Coach Johnson was selected coach of the year and was selected as an assistant coach of the South's Shrine Bowl Team.

This year's basketball team was led by seniors, Sue Focht, Janice Else, and Cynthia Williams.


The team had an improving season ending with a record of 6-13. The Jayettes ended up fourth overall in the Tall Corn Conference and third in defense which really put the team on the map.

Two players were named to honorable mention All-Conference. They were, Amy Wright on defense and Janice Else on offense.


