With the returning lettermen and young talent next year could be a very successful year.

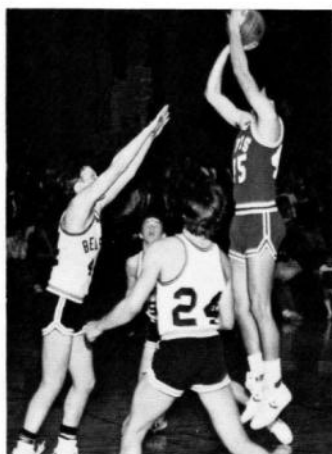

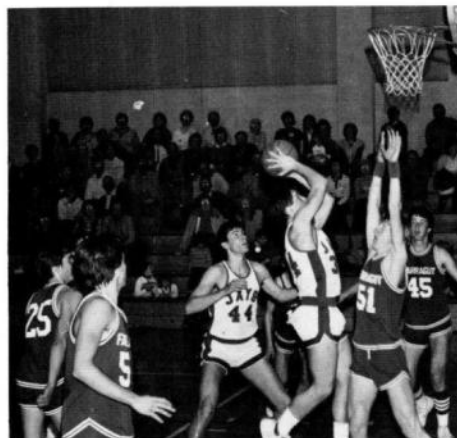

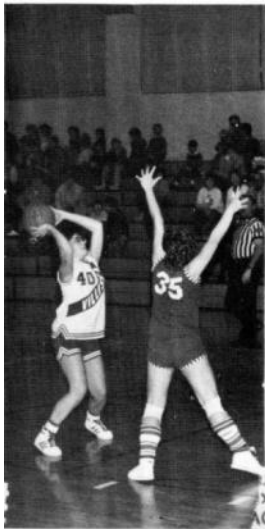


The Jayette Basketball season finished with a much improved record of 6-13. Seven seniors led the team to a tie for 5th in the conference with Bedford.
