The Villisca School was fortunate to have a very dedicated and special teacher among their staff for nearly twenty-nine years prior to the time of her death. Miss Nelson (as she was known by all of her students) graduated from Walnut High School and received her degree in Elementary Education from Drake University in Des Moines. Beginning her teaching career in 1924 at the age of seventeen, she taught at a number of country schools before teaching in the Villisca Elementary program.

Miss Nelson touched the lives of a great many of Villisca's students and will be remembered by all. She continued teaching up until the time when she entered the hospital and passed away on December 23, 1988. As expressed by Margaret Posten: "'H' is for her heart from which came love, joy, sorrow, charity, and serenity." She will be greatly missed.

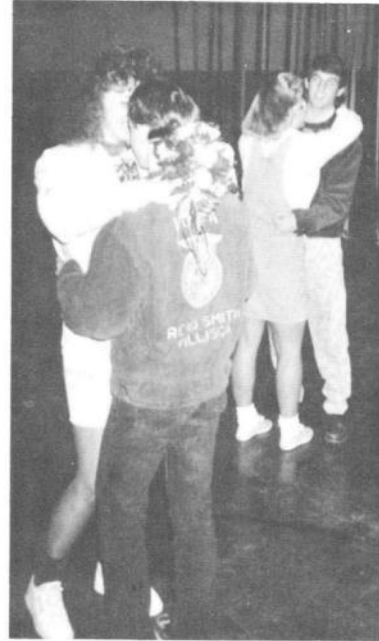
