GRADUATION

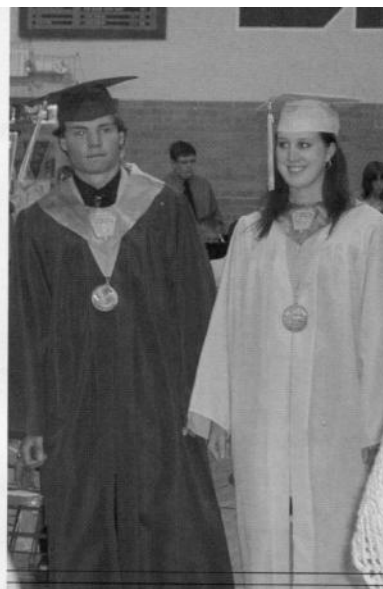

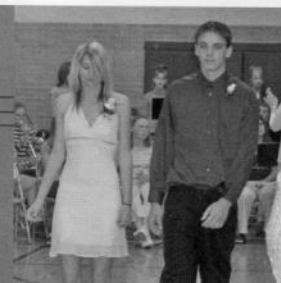

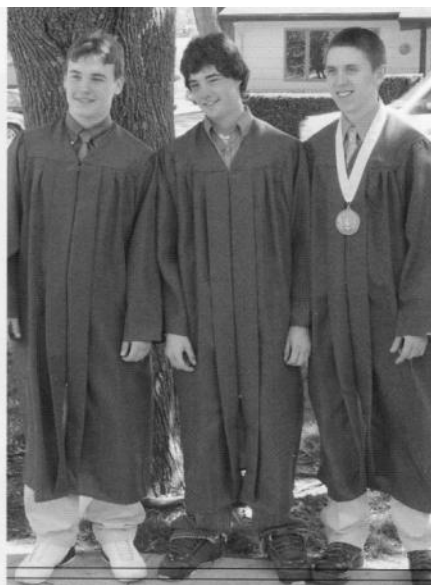

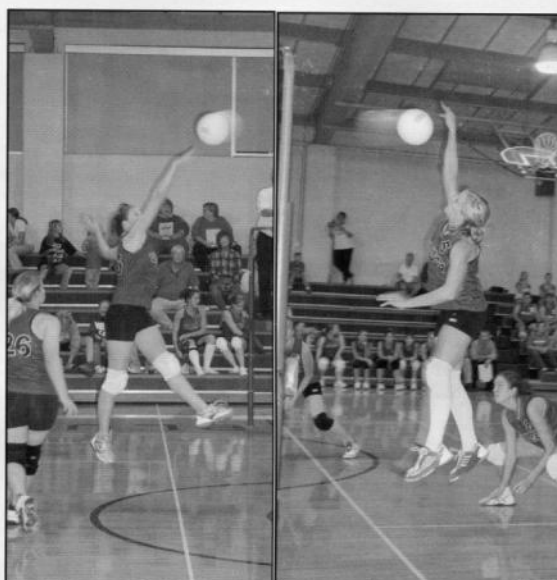

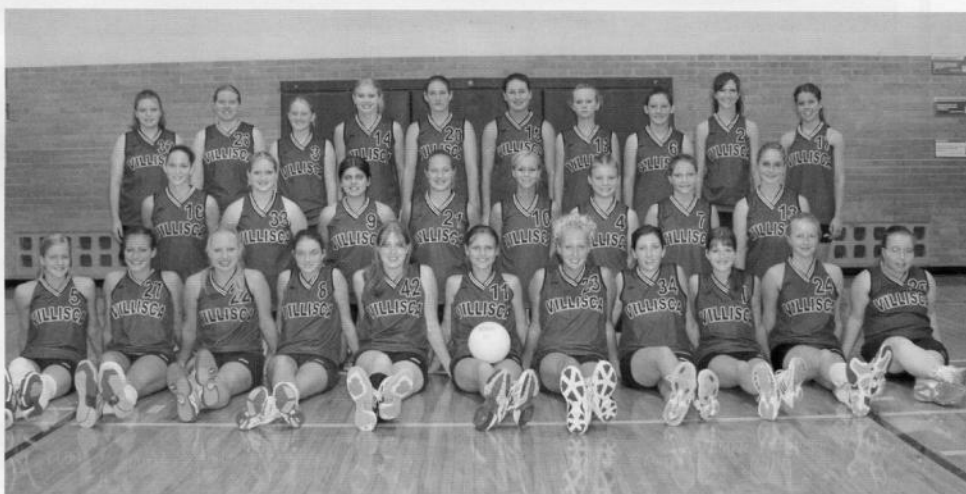

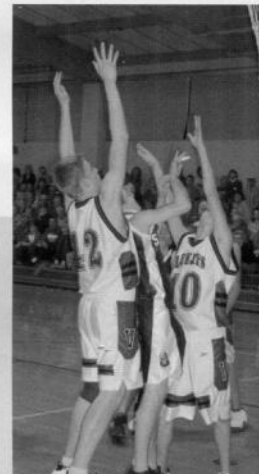

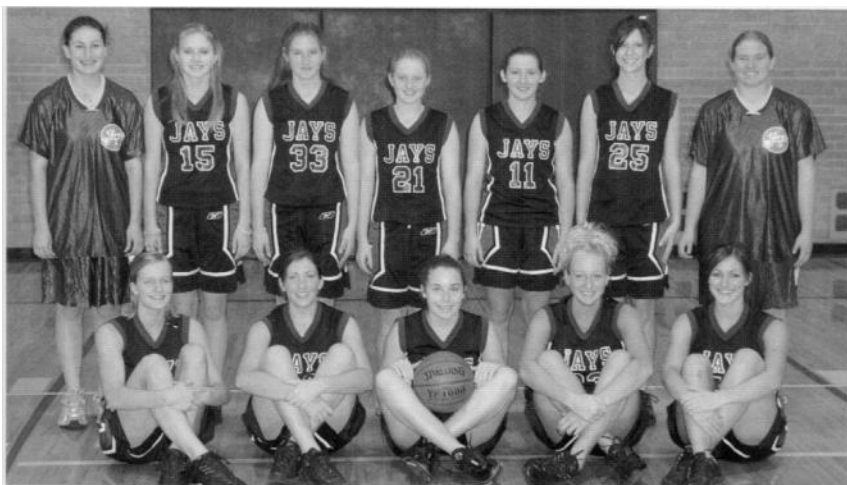

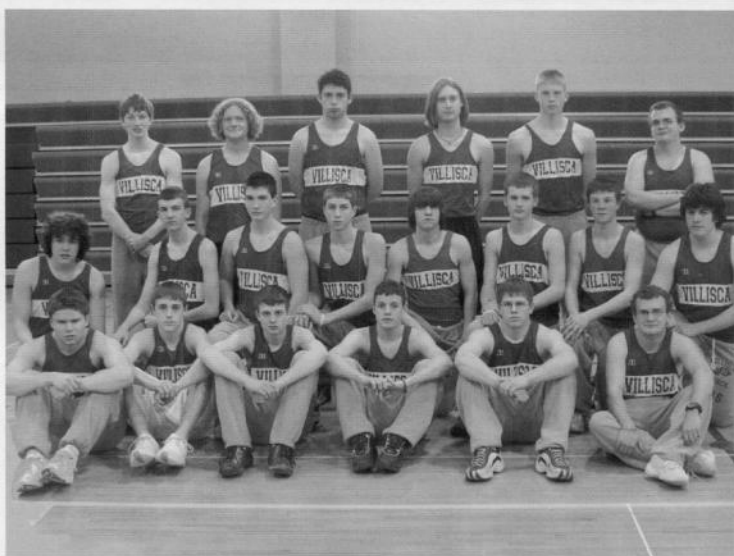

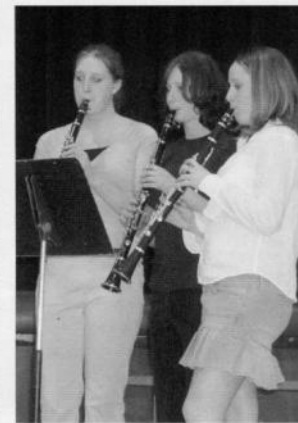

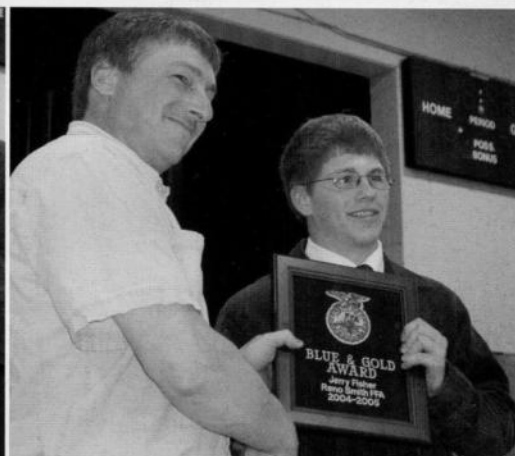

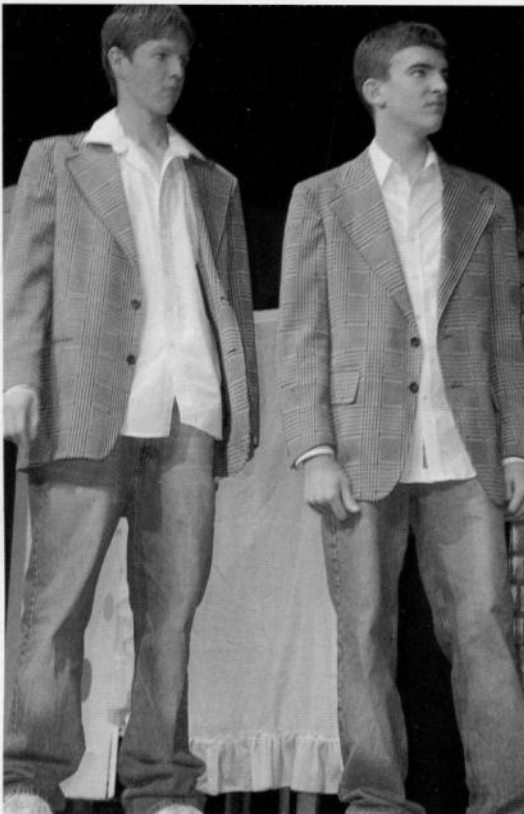

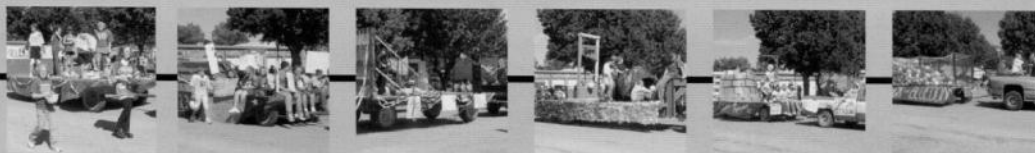

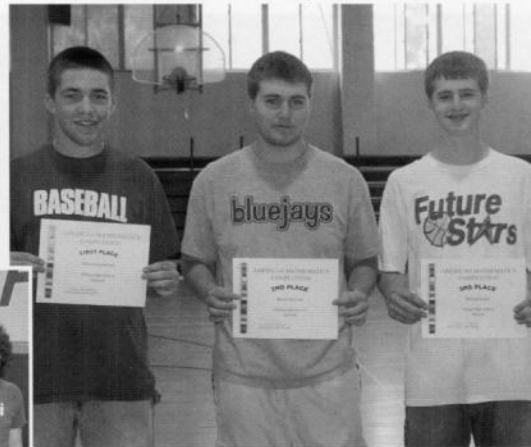
