In 1945, Marvin and Darvin Honneke and John Cooney left our class. Patsy Rhany and David Hedstrom joined us as 2nd graders.

In the third grade, with Miss Elinor Fellows, as our teacher. Those who joined the class were Sherry Odson, Charles Griffith, Ivan Stephans, and Ruth Units. Jimmy Cozad, Marilyn Laco, Bobby Watts and Amelia Williams moved away.
